## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to certain searches of female inmates by the Texas
- 3 Department of Criminal Justice.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 501.026, Government Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 501.026. LIMITATION ON CERTAIN SEARCHES. (a) The
- 8 department shall adopt a policy regarding a search of any room or
- 9 other area that occurs while a female inmate who is not fully
- 10 clothed is present in the room or area. The policy must:
- 11 (1) require that the search be conducted by a female
- 12 correctional officer if one is available;
- 13 (2) include staffing procedures to ensure the
- 14 availability of female officers; and
- 15 (3) provide that if it is necessary for a male
- 16 correctional officer to conduct the search, the officer must submit
- 17 a written report explaining the reasons for the search to the warden
- 18 not later than 72 hours after the search.
- 19 (b) The department shall adopt a policy regarding a search
- 20 of a female inmate who is accessing programs offered to inmates in
- 21 the custody of the department, including educational, vocational,
- 22 <u>substance use treatment, rehabilitation, life skills training, and</u>
- 23 prerelease programs. The policy may not permit a visual body cavity
- 24 search except in exigent circumstances or under a reasonable

- 1 suspicion that a visual body cavity search is warranted.
- 2 (c) For purposes of Subsection (b):
- 3 (1) "Exigent circumstances" means a set of temporary
- 4 and unforeseen circumstances that require immediate action in order
- 5 to combat a threat to the security or institutional order of a
- 6 facility. The term does not include routine access to programs
- 7 offered to an inmate in the custody of the department, including
- 8 educational, vocational, substance use treatment, rehabilitation,
- 9 life skills training, and prerelease programs.
- 10 (2) "Visual body cavity search" means the observation
- of an inmate with all clothing removed to permit a visual inspection
- 12 of the inmate's anal or genital opening.
- 13 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 14 of this Act, the Texas Department of Criminal Justice shall adopt
- 15 the policy required by Section 501.026(b), Government Code, as
- 16 added by this Act.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
