8	(a) A school district may offer to students in grades 9 through 12
9	an elective course on automobile maintenance that meets the
10	requirements for an elective credit under Section 28.025.
11	(b) A course under this section must include instruction in
12	and information relating to:
13	(1) checking and refilling or replacing:
14	(A) engine oil;
15	(B) coolant;
16	(C) brake fluid;
17	(D) transmission fluid; and
18	(E) power steering fluid;
19	(2) checking tire pressure and tire tread depth;
20	(3) changing a tire, performing a tire rotation, and
21	repairing a flat tire;
22	(4) battery maintenance, including the correct method

1	(A) fuses;
2	(B) engine air filters; and
3	(C) cabin air filters;
4	(6) the meaning of common dashboard warning lights;

8	fluids or hazardous materials.
9	SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
10	school year.
11	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
12	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
13	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
14	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
15	Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
