8 (9) a phone number operational 24 hours a day, seven 9 days a week that a person may call to verify the validity of the 10 identification card; and

11 (10) the position or rank held by the honorably 12 retired peace officer at the time of the officer's retirement.

13 SECTION 2. Section 614.1241(b), Government Code, is amended 14 to read as follows:

(b) The identification card must include:

16 (1) the full name of the qualified retired law 17 enforcement officer;

18 (2) a photograph of the qualified retired law

(9) a phone number operational 24 hours a day, seven days a week, that a person may call to verify the validity of the identification card; and
