- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 26, Water Code, is amended 6 by adding Section 26.0231 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 26.0231. SALINITY OF BAYS AND ESTUARIES. The
- 8 commission shall incorporate in standards set under Section 26.023:
- 9 <u>(1) numeric salinity gradients for bays and estuaries</u>
- 10 where site-specific salinity studies exist; and
- 11 (2) narrative salinity criteria for bays and estuaries
- 12 <u>listing specific species within bays and estuaries to support</u>
- 13 <u>attainable estuarine dependent aquatic life.</u>
- 14 SECTION 2. (a) The Texas Commission on Environmental
- 15 Quality shall ensure that water quality standards set by the
- 16 commission under Section 26.023, Water Code, comply with Section
- 17 26.0231, Water Code, as added by this Act, in the first revision of
- 18 the commission's relevant rules that occurs after the effective
- 19 date of this Act.

- 20 (b) Not later than September 1, 2026, the Texas Commission
- 21 on Environmental Quality shall publish on its Internet website a
- 22 report on the results of long-term studies conducted between 2003
- 23 and 2025 by the commission and other state agencies of estuarine
- 24 salinity gradients. The report must assess, based on available

- 1 information from stakeholders and the studies, the effects of
- 2 additional wastewater loading, desalination, and changes in
- 3 hydrological conditions and rainfall on estuarine salinity
- 4 gradients and estuarine dependent wildlife.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
