SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 419, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 419.0471 to read as follows: 1-20 1-21

Sec. 419.0471. EXTENSION TO COMPLY WITH COMMISSION STANDARDS. (a) A fire department may request an extension from the commission to comply with the minimum standards adopted under 1-22 1-23 1-24 Section 419.047. The commission shall grant a request for an extension if the fire department provides evidence the commission finds sufficient to justify the extension. (b) The commission shall adopt rules necessary to implement 1-25 1-26
