- EXPENSES. (a) If a present or former employee of the department who 8
- 9 is or was involved in activities relating to the protection of
- children or elderly persons or persons with disabilities is 10
- 11 criminally prosecuted for conduct involving the
- 12 misfeasance or nonfeasance in the course and scope of the person's
- employment and is found not guilty after a trial or appeal or if the 13
- 14 complaint or indictment is dismissed without a plea of guilty or
- nolo contendere being entered, the department may indemnify the 15
- person or the person's estate for the reasonable attorney's fees 16
- incurred in defense of the prosecution up to a maximum of \$10,000. 17
- (b) If a present employee of the department who is involved
- in activities relating to the protection of children or elderly 19
- persons or persons with disabilities seeks a protective or 20
