Section 212.905, Local Government Code, 5 is amended by amending Subsection (h) and adding Subsection (h-1) to 6 read as follows: 7 A municipality may not prohibit the removal of or impose 8 (h) a tree mitigation fee for the removal of [a tree that]: 9 a tree that is diseased or dead; [or] 10 (1) a tree that poses an imminent or immediate threat 11 (2) 12 to persons or property; or 13 (3) except as provided by Subsection (h-1), an Ashe 14 juniper tree located on a residential property. (h-1) Subsection (h)(3) does not apply to an area located: 15 (1) within 15 miles of the boundary of a military base, 16 as defined by Section 43.0117, at which an active training program 17 is conducted; and 18 (2) in a county with a population of more than two 19 million. 20 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
