9	INFORMATION. (a) Information relating to the financial condition
10	of a perpetual care cemetery or fund the department obtains
11	directly or indirectly, through examination or otherwise, other
12	than a published statement, is confidential.
13	(b) A department file or record relating to the financial
14	condition of a perpetual care cemetery or fund is confidential.
15	(c) The commissioner may disclose information described by
16	Subsection (a) or (b) to an agency, department, or instrumentality
17	of this or another state or the United States if the commissioner
18	determines disclosure is in the best interest of the public and
19	necessary or proper to enforce the laws of this or another state or
20	the United States.
21	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
22	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
23	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
24	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
