8	state agency shall grant each employee of the agency who is entitled
9	to pursue a protest under Subchapter C, Chapter 41, Tax Code, at
10	least eight hours of leave each fiscal year without a deduction in
11	salary or a loss of other forms of leave to pursue the protest under
12	that subchapter.
13	SECTION 2. Chapter 180, Local Government Code, is amended

- by adding Section 180.0095 to read as follows:

 Sec. 180.0095. LEAVE TO PROTEST PROPERTY TAX ACTIONS. (a)
- 16 In this section, "political subdivision" includes a municipality,
- 17 county, school district, water district, or any other special
- 18 purpose district or authority.
- (b) The governing body of a political subdivision shall
- 20 grant each employee of the political subdivision who is entitled to
- 21 pursue a protest under Subchapter C, Chapter 41, Tax Code, at least
- 22 <u>eight hours of leave each fiscal year without a deduction in salary</u>
- 23 or loss of vacation leave, sick leave, or other paid leave to pursue
- 24 the protest under that subchapter.

- 1 SECTION 3. Section 180.0095, Local Government Code, as
- 2 added by this Act, applies only to the fiscal year of a political
- 3 subdivision that begins on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
