A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the installation and ownership of certain outdoor
- 3 storage containers; authorizing a fee.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter I, Chapter 26, Water
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 SUBCHAPTER I. UNDERGROUND AND ABOVEGROUND STORAGE [TANKS]
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 26.341(b), Water Code, is amended to
- 9 read as follows:
- 10 (b) The legislature declares that it is the policy of this
- 11 state and the purpose of this subchapter to:
- 12 (1) maintain and protect the quality of groundwater
- 13 and surface water resources in the state from certain substances in
- 14 underground and aboveground storage tanks that may pollute
- 15 groundwater and surface water resources;
- 16 (2) require the use of all reasonable methods,
- 17 including risk-based corrective action, to implement this policy;
- 18 [and]
- 19 (3) promote the safety of storage vessels as defined
- 20 in Section 26.3442, by adopting requirements for the design,
- 21 construction, operation, and maintenance of storage vessels, with
- 22 the objective of protecting groundwater and surface water resources
- 23 in the event of accidents and natural disasters; and
- 24 (4) ensure that outdoor storage containers, as defined

- 1 by Section 26.3445, are not located close to private residences.
- 2 SECTION 3. Subchapter I, Chapter 26, Water Code, is amended
- 3 by adding Section 26.3445 to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 26.3445. LOCATION OF OUTDOOR STORAGE CONTAINERS. (a)
- 5 In this section, "outdoor storage container" means a nonvehicular
- 6 device that is:
- 7 (1) made of nonearthen materials;
- 8 (2) located on or above the surface of the ground and
- 9 not inside a structure;
- 10 (3) located at, or is a part of, a commercial facility,
- 11 including a for-hire storage terminal; and
- 12 (4) designed to contain a regulated substance.
- 13 (b) A person may not install or operate an outdoor storage
- 14 container in a location 2,000 feet or less from a private residence.
- 15 <u>(c)</u> An owner of an outdoor storage container shall register
- 16 the container with the commission not later than the 30th day after
- 17 the date the container is installed or the date the owner acquires
- 18 an installed container from a previous owner. An owner of an
- 19 outdoor storage container that was installed before September 1,
- 20 2025, shall register the container with the commission not later
- 21 than March 1, 2026. An owner of an outdoor storage container
- 22 required to register the container as an aboveground storage tank
- 23 or a storage vessel under this subchapter is not required to
- 24 register the container under this section.
- 25 (d) The commission shall conduct annual on-site inspections
- 26 of outdoor storage containers registered under this subchapter to
- 27 determine compliance with this section. This subsection does not

- 1 limit the commission's ability to inspect a container under other
- 2 state or federal law.
- 3 (e) The commission by rule shall impose a fee for
- 4 registering an outdoor storage container under this section in an
- 5 amount sufficient to recover the reasonable costs of:
- 6 (1) implementing the registration program; and
- 7 (2) inspecting registered facilities.
- 8 <u>(f) An outdoor storage container is exempt from the</u>
- 9 application of this section if the container is:
- 10 (1) a farm or residential tank with a capacity of 1,100
- 11 gallons or less used for storing motor fuel for noncommercial
- 12 purposes;
- 13 (2) used for storing heating oil for consumptive use
- 14 on the premises where stored;
- 15 (3) a septic tank;
- 16 (4) a surface impoundment, pit, pond, or lagoon;
- 17 (5) a storm water or waste water collection system;
- 18 (6) a flow-through process tank;
- 19 (7) a tank, liquid trap, gathering line, or other
- 20 facility used in connection with an activity associated with the
- 21 exploration, development, or production of oil, gas, or geothermal
- 22 resources, or any other activity regulated by the Railroad
- 23 Commission of Texas under Section 91.101, Natural Resources Code;
- 24 or
- 25 (8) a transformer or other electrical equipment that
- 26 contains a regulated substance and that is used in the transmission
- 27 of electricity, to the extent that such a transformer or equipment

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- 1 is exempted by the United States Environmental Protection Agency
- 2 under 40 C.F.R. Part 280.
- 3 (g) This section does not limit the authority of a
- 4 municipality to adopt an ordinance prohibiting the installation or
- 5 operation of an outdoor storage container in a location more than
- 6 2,000 feet from a private residence.
- 7 SECTION 4. Notwithstanding Section 26.3445, Water Code, as
- 8 added by this Act, an owner of an outdoor storage container, as
- 9 defined by Section 26.3445(a), Water Code, as added by this Act, is
- 10 not required to register the container before March 1, 2026.
- 11 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
