- 2 relating to the parking of a commercial motor vehicle in or near
- 3 certain residential subdivisions.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 545.307, Transportation
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 545.307. [OVERNIGHT] PARKING OF COMMERCIAL MOTOR
- 8 VEHICLE IN OR NEAR RESIDENTIAL SUBDIVISION.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 545.307, Transportation Code, is amended
- 10 by amending Subsections (b), (b-1), (c), and (d) and adding
- 11 Subsection (e-1) to read as follows:
- 12 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (b-1), [after 10 p.m.
- 13 and before 6 a.m., a person may not park a commercial motor vehicle
- 14 or leave the vehicle parked on a street that is maintained by a
- 15 county or municipality and for which signs are posted as provided by
- 16 Subsection (c) if the street:
- 17 (1) is located within a residential subdivision; or
- 18 (2) is adjacent to a residential subdivision and
- 19 within 1,000 feet of the property line of a residence, school, place
- 20 of worship, [or park, or retail area.
- 21 (b-1) A person may park a commercial motor vehicle or leave
- 22 the vehicle parked on a street for which signs are posted as
- 23 provided by Subsection (c) if the commercial motor vehicle is
- 24 parked for a period not to exceed two hours, and either:

- 1 (1) the operator of the commercial motor vehicle:
- 2 (A) is present in the vehicle the entire period
- 3 the vehicle remains parked; and
- 4 (B) is taking a rest break or other lawfully
- 5 mandated break; or
- 6 (2) the commercial motor vehicle:
- 7  $\underline{\text{(A)}}$  [\frac{(1)}{1}] is transporting persons or property to
- 8 or from the residential subdivision or performing work in the
- 9 subdivision; and
- 10  $\underline{\text{(B)}}$  [ $\frac{\text{(2)}}{\text{)}}$ ] remains parked in or adjacent to the
- 11 subdivision only for the period necessary to complete the
- 12 transportation or work.
- 13 (c)  $\underline{A}$  [The residents of a residential subdivision may
- 14 petition a county or municipality in which a residential [the]
- 15 subdivision is located  $\frac{\text{shall post}}{\text{post}}$  [for the posting of] signs
- 16 prohibiting the [overnight] parking of a commercial motor vehicle
- 17 in the subdivision or on a street adjacent to the subdivision and
- 18 within 1,000 feet of the property line of a residence, school, place
- 19 of worship, [or] park, or retail area. [The petition must be signed
- 20 by at least 25 percent of the owners or tenants of residences in the
- 21 subdivision. Not more than one person for each residence may sign
- 22 the petition, and each person signing must be at least 18 years of
- 23 age. Promptly after the filing of a petition meeting the
- 24 requirements of this subsection and subject to Subsection (d), the
- 25 county or municipality receiving the petition shall post the
- 26 signs.] The signs must:
- 27 (1) be posted:

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- 1 (A) at each entrance of the subdivision through
- 2 which a commercial motor vehicle may enter the subdivision or
- 3 within the subdivision if there is not defined entrance to the
- 4 subdivision; or
- 5 (B) on a street adjacent to the subdivision; and
- 6 (2) state, in letters at least two inches in height,
- 7 that [overnight] parking of a commercial motor vehicle is
- 8 prohibited at all times in the subdivision or on a street adjacent
- 9 to the subdivision.
- 10 (d) A county or municipality [receiving a petition under
- 11 Subsection (c) may condition the posting of the signs on payment by
- 12 the residents of the residential subdivision of the cost of
- 13 providing the signs.
- 14 (e-1) A commercial motor vehicle found to be parked in
- 15 violation of Subsection (b) may immediately be towed.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
