12	(2) reduce to the extent practicable the number of
13	state agency positions requiring an employee to hold a bachelor's
14	degree as a condition of employment;
15	(3) evaluate ways to expand career advancement
16	opportunities for state agency employees who do not hold a
17	bachelor's degree; and
18	(4) report the information gathered as required by
19	this subsection to the governor's budget office and the Legislative
20	Budget Board in the time required by Subsection (a)(2).
21	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
