## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to creating a civil penalty and providing for injunctive relief against museums that display certain obscene or harmful 3 material. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Chapter 402, Government Code, is amended by 7 adding Subchapter D to read as follows: SUBCHAPTER D. ENFORCEMENT 8 9 Sec. 402.071. MUSEUM DISPLAYING CERTAIN OBSCENE OR HARMFUL MATERIAL: CIVIL PENALTY AND INJUNCTION. (a) A museum that displays 10 obscene or harmful material in violation of Section 43.22, 43.23, 11 or 43.24, Penal Code, is liable to the state in an amount not to 12 exceed \$500,000 for each item of displayed material and each day the 13 display continues. 14 15 (b) The attorney general may bring an action to obtain: 16 (1) injunctive relief; (2) a civil penalty as provided by Subsection (a); and 17 18 (3) reasonable attorney's fees and reasonably incurred 19 costs of investigation or litigation. 20 (c) An injunction issued under this section must require, in addition to any other relief, that a museum publicly displaying 21 obscene or harmful material as described by Subsection (a) remove 22 23 the material from public display indefinitely. 24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
