A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to prohibiting the use of electric resistance as a primary
- 3 heat source in certain residential buildings.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 388, Health and Safety Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 388.0045 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 388.0045. USE OF ELECTRIC RESISTANCE AS PRIMARY
- 8 HEATING SOURCE PROHIBITED IN CERTAIN RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS. (a)
- 9 This section applies only to residential buildings with a dwelling
- 10 area greater than 500 square feet.
- 11 (b) Notwithstanding any requirement contained in an energy
- 12 code adopted under Section 388.003(a) or (b), or a local amendment
- 13 adopted under Section 388.003(d), and except as provided by
- 14 Subsection (c), the primary heat source for a dwelling unit may not
- 15 be electric resistance heating.
- (c) This section does not apply to a dwelling unit that is
- 17 cooled using chilled water.
- SECTION 2. (a) Section 388.0045, Health and Safety Code, as
- 19 added by this Act, applies only to residential building
- 20 construction, remodeling, alteration, enlargement, or repair that
- 21 begins under an agreement made on or after January 1, 2026, or that
- 22 begins, in the absence of an agreement, on or after that date.
- 23 Residential building construction, remodeling, alteration,
- 24 enlargement, or repair that begins under an agreement made before

- 1 January 1, 2026, or that begins, in the absence of an agreement,
- 2 before that date is governed by the law in effect when the agreement
- 3 was made or the activity began, as appropriate, and that law is
- 4 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 5 (b) Not later than December 1, 2025, municipalities shall
- 6 establish rules and take other necessary actions to implement
- 7 Section 388.0045, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
