## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the storage or disposal of high-level radioactive
3 waste.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 401.0525(c), Health & Safety Code, is 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (c) With the exception of a permit for a storage facility
- 8 located at the site of [currently or formerly operating] nuclear
- 9 power reactors and [currently or formerly operating] nuclear
- 10 research and test reactors operated by a university, the commission
- 11 may not under the authority given to the agency under Section 301,
- 12 304, or 401 of the Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C. Sections 1311, 1314,
- 13 and 1341) issue a general construction permit or approve a
- 14 Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan under Section 26.040, Water
- 15 Code, or issue a permit under the Texas Pollutant Discharge
- 16 Elimination System Program under Section 26.027, 26.028, or 26.121,
- 17 Water Code, for the construction or operation of a facility that is
- 18 licensed for the <u>disposal or</u> storage of high-level radioactive
- 19 waste by the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission under 10
- 20 C.F.R. Part 72. Section 401.005 does not apply to this subsection.
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 401.072, Health & Safety Code, is
- 22 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 401.072. DISPOSAL OR STORAGE OF HIGH-LEVEL RADIOACTIVE
- 24 WASTE. With the exception of storage at the site of [currently or

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- 1 formerly operating] nuclear power reactors and [currently or
- 2 formerly operating] nuclear research and test reactors operated by
- 3 a university, a person, including the compact waste disposal
- 4 facility license holder, may not dispose of or store high-level
- 5 radioactive waste in this state.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
