- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 146.002, Civil Practice and Remedies
- 6 Code, is amended by amending Subsections (a) and (d) and adding
- 7 Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:
- 8 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) or (c) and subject
- 9 to Subsection (c-1), a health care service provider shall bill a
- 10 patient or other responsible person for services provided to the
- 11 patient not later than the first day of the 11th month after the
- 12 date the services are provided.
- 13 (c-1) If a health care service provider provides services to
- 14 a patient that are related to a personal injury claim for which the
- 15 patient is represented by an attorney and unless otherwise directed
- 16 by the patient or other responsible person, the provider may
- 17 satisfy the requirements of Subsection (a) by submitting the bill
- 18 to the patient's attorney not later than the first day of the 11th
- 19 month after the date the services are provided.
- 20 (d) For purposes of this section, the date of billing is the
- 21 date on which the health care service provider's bill is:
- 22 (1) mailed to the patient, [or] responsible person, or
- 23 attorney representing the patient, as applicable, postage prepaid,
- 24 at the address of the patient, [or] responsible person, or attorney

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- 1 representing the patient as shown on the health care service
- 2 provider's records; or
- 3 (2) mailed or otherwise submitted to the issuer of the
- 4 health benefit plan or third party payor as required by the health
- 5 benefit plan or third party payor.
- 6 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 7 to a health care service provided on or after the effective date of
- 8 this Act. A health care service provided before the effective date
- 9 of this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before the
- 10 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
- 11 that purpose.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
