6	Code, is amended by adding Section 181.105 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 181.105. REQUIRED INFORMATION REGARDING CONSUMER
8	ACCESS TO HEALTH RECORDS AND COMPLAINTS. (a) Except as provided by
9	Subsection (b), a covered entity shall prominently post on the
10	entity's Internet website and at any entity facility detailed
11	instructions for a consumer to:
12	(1) request the consumer's health care records from
13	the entity;
14	(2) contact the disciplinary or licensing authority
15	for the covered entity; and
16	(3) file a consumer complaint as described by Section
17	<u>181.103.</u>
18	(b) This section does not apply to a covered entity that
19	conducts claims processing, data processing, data analysis,
20	utilization review, or billing on behalf of another covered entity
21	that provides health care services directly to consumers.
22	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
