- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 772, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 772.013 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 772.013. GRANT PROGRAM FOR CERTAIN PEACE OFFICERS WITH
- 8 MASTER PROFICIENCY CERTIFICATE. (a) In this section:
- 9 (1) "Criminal justice division" means the criminal
- 10 justice division established under Section 772.006.
- 11 (2) "Law enforcement agency" means an agency of this
- 12 state or an agency of a political subdivision of this state
- 13 authorized by law to employ peace officers.
- 14 (3) "Peace officer" means a person elected, employed,
- 15 or appointed as a peace officer under Article 2A.001, Code of
- 16 Criminal Procedure, or other law.
- 17 (b) From money appropriated specifically for that purpose,
- 18 the criminal justice division may establish a grant program for the
- 19 public purpose of fostering the professional development of peace
- 20 <u>officers employed in this state.</u>
- 21 (c) To be eligible for a grant under this section, a person
- 22 must:
- 23 (1) hold a master proficiency certificate issued by
- 24 the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement under Section 1701.402,

- Occupations Code;

  (2) be employed on a full-time basis as a peace officer

  by a law enforcement agency; and

  (3) meet any other eligibility criteria established by

  the criminal justice division.

  (d) Only the following persons may apply for a grant under
- 10 this section; or
- 11 (2) a person who meets the eligibility criteria for a
  12 grant under this section with the consent of the person's employing
- 13 law enforcement agency.
- (e) The criminal justice division may award a grant under
- 15 this section only to a law enforcement agency. The law enforcement
- 16 agency may use the money only to increase the compensation of the
- 17 employee who applied for the grant or for whom the agency applied
- 18 <u>for the grant.</u>
- 19 (f) If the grant program is established under Subsection
- 20 (b), the criminal justice division shall establish procedures for:
- 21 (1) processing grant applications in addition to any
- 22 other application procedures prescribed by this section;
- 23 (2) evaluating grant applications; and
- 24 (3) monitoring the use of a grant awarded under the
- 25 program and ensuring compliance with any condition of a grant.
- 26 (g) The criminal justice division shall award grants under
- 27 this section in an amount equal to \$6,500 for each award.

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- 1 (h) A grant awarded under this section may not be awarded to
- 2 the same person more than one time.
- 3 SECTION 2. The criminal justice division established under
- 4 Section 772.006, Government Code, may award a grant under Section
- 5 772.013, Government Code, as added by this Act, only with respect to
- 6 a master proficiency certificate issued under Section 1701.402,
- 7 Occupations Code, on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
