Section 51.3525(d), Education Code, is amended 5 by amending Subsection (d)(2), adding Subsection (d)(3), and 6 7 renumbering subsequent sections to read as follows: Subsection (b)(1) may not be construed to apply to: 8 (d) (1) academic course instruction; 9 scholarly research, including research funded or 10 (2) 11 to be funded wholly or partly by government or private grants, or a 12 creative work by an institution of higher education's students, faculty, postdoctoral fellows, or other research personnel or the 13 14 dissemination of that research or work; (3) information or guidance by faculty or staff on 15 16 career opportunities and grant applications; (34) an activity of a student organization registered 17 with or recognized by an institution of higher education; 18 (45) guest speakers or performers on short-term 19 20 engagements; 21 (56) a policy, practice, procedure, program, or 22 activity to enhance student academic achievement or postgraduate 23 outcomes that is designed and implemented without regard to race, sex, color, or ethnicity; 24

(67) data collection; or

(78) student recruitment or admissions.

3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
