1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the storage of alcoholic beverages by the holder of a  
1-22 passenger transportation permit.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 48.03(b), Alcoholic Beverage Code, is  
1-25 amended to read as follows:

1-26 (b) The holder of a passenger transportation permit issued  
1-27 under this section may:

1-28 (1) sell or serve alcoholic beverages in or from any  
1-29 size container on a commercial passenger airplane operated in  
1-30 compliance with a valid license, permit, or certificate issued  
1-31 under the authority of the United States or of this state, even  
1-32 though the plane, in the course of its flight, may cross an area in  
1-33 which the sale of alcoholic beverages is prohibited; and

1-34 (2) store alcoholic beverages in sealed containers of  
1-35 any size at any airport regularly served by the permittee or a  
1-36 location within five miles of any airport regularly served by the  
1-37 permittee in the same county as the airport, in accordance with  
1-38 rules and regulations promulgated by the commission.

1-39 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
