- 2 relating to severance pay for political subdivision employees and
- 3 independent contractors.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 180, Local Government Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 180.011 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 180.011. LIMITATION ON SEVERANCE PAY FOR EMPLOYEES AND
- 8 INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS. (a) In this section:
- 9 <u>(1) "Misconduct" means an act or omission by an</u>
- 10 employee or contractor of a political subdivision in the
- 11 performance of the employee's or contractor's duties that the
- 12 governing body of the political subdivision determines to be
- 13 misconduct. The term includes any finding of criminal conduct.
- 14 (2) "Severance pay" means dismissal or separation
- 15 income paid on termination of:
- 16 (A) the employment of an employee that is in
- 17 addition to the employee's usual earnings from the employer at the
- 18 time of termination; or
- 19 (B) the contract of an independent contractor of
- 20 <u>a political subdivision that is in addition to the contractor's</u>
- 21 usual earnings from the political subdivision as prescribed by the
- 22 contract.
- 23 (b) A political subdivision that enters into an employment
- 24 agreement or contract, or renewal or renegotiation of an existing

- 1 employment agreement or contract, that contains a provision for
- 2 severance pay must include:
- 3 (1) a requirement that severance pay that is paid from
- 4 public funds may not exceed the amount of compensation, at the rate
- 5 at the termination of employment or of the contract, the employee or
- 6 independent contractor would have been paid for 12 weeks, excluding
- 7 paid time off or accrued vacation leave; and
- 8 (2) a prohibition of the provision of severance pay
- 9 when the employee or independent contractor is terminated for
- 10 misconduct.
- 11 (c) A political subdivision shall post each severance
- 12 agreement in a prominent place on the political subdivision's
- 13 Internet website.
- 14 (d) This subsection applies to an action brought against a
- 15 political subdivision by an employee or independent contractor of
- 16 the political subdivision arising from the termination of the
- 17 person's employment or contract. A court may not issue a writ of
- 18 execution or mandamus in connection with a judgment in the action if
- 19 the judgment does not comply with this section.
- SECTION 2. Section 180.011, Local Government Code, as added
- 21 by this Act, applies only to an employment agreement or contract
- 22 entered into or an action filed on or after the effective date of
- 23 this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
