A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to critical infrastructure facility emergency response maps and the critical infrastructure emergency response map grant program.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 424, Government Code, is amended by adding Subchapter D to read as follows:

SUBCHAPTER D. EMERGENCY RESPONSE MAP AND GRANT PROGRAM

Sec. 424.151. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:

(1) "Department" means the Department of Public Safety of the State of Texas.

(2) "Fund" means the critical infrastructure emergency response map fund created under Section 424.155.

(3) "Grant program" means the critical infrastructure emergency response map grant program established under Section 424.154.

(4) "Public safety agency" and "public safety answering point" have the meanings assigned by Section 771.001, Health and Safety Code.

Sec. 424.152. APPLICABILITY. This subchapter applies only to a critical infrastructure facility that is:

(1) a public or private airport depicted in any current aeronautical chart published by the Federal Aviation Administration; or

1 (2) a military installation owned or operated by or
2 for the federal government, this state, or another governmental
3 entity.

4 Sec. 424.153. EMERGENCY RESPONSE MAP AND TOUR. (a) Each
5 critical infrastructure facility to which this subchapter applies
6 shall provide to the department and appropriate public safety
7 agencies:

8 (1) an accurate emergency response map of the facility
9 that is developed in accordance with the standards described by
10 Subsection (b); and

11 (2) an opportunity to tour the facility using the map
12 described by Subdivision (1) to verify the map's accuracy.

13 (b) An emergency response map must:

14 (1) include:

15 (A) an accurate floor plan overlaid on current,
16 verified aerial imagery of the facility and its surrounding land
17 and a site-specific label for each building of the facility;

18 (B) a label for each:

19 (i) room;

20 (ii) named hallway; and

21 (iii) external door or stairwell number;

22 and

23 (C) the location of each:

24 (i) known hazard;

25 (ii) critical utility;

26 (iii) key box;

27 (iv) automated external defibrillator; and

1 (v) trauma kit;

2 (2) conform to, integrate with, and be accessible by
3 software used by the department, entities operating a local public
4 safety answering point, or appropriate public safety agencies
5 without imposing a fee or requiring the purchase of additional
6 software to access the map and associated data;

7 (3) be in a format capable of being printed, shared
8 electronically, or integrated into an interactive software
9 application; and

10 (4) be in a format easily modified or updated.

11 (c) A critical infrastructure facility to which this
12 subchapter applies may only provide an emergency response map to
13 the department and appropriate public safety agencies for purposes
14 of developing a verified source of critical infrastructure mapping
15 data in this state and ensuring efficient emergency response for
16 the facility.

17 (d) A critical infrastructure facility to which this
18 subchapter applies may not provide or make available to the public
19 an emergency response map.

20 Sec. 424.154. CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE EMERGENCY RESPONSE
21 MAP GRANT PROGRAM. (a) The department shall establish and
22 administer a grant program to provide mapping services for critical
23 infrastructure facilities to which this subchapter applies to
24 develop emergency response maps required under Section 424.153.

25 (b) A grant awarded under this section may only be used to
26 obtain mapping services for a critical infrastructure facility to
27 which this subchapter applies to provide the emergency response map

1 required under Section 424.153.

2 (c) A mapping service provider who is a recipient of grant
3 money shall provide an emergency response map to the critical
4 infrastructure facility, the department, and appropriate public
5 safety agencies and may only charge a fee for the initial production
6 cost for the map.

7 (d) The department shall adopt rules to administer the grant
8 program established under this section, including eligibility
9 standards and procedures for applying for a grant under this
10 section.

11 (e) The department may award a grant under the grant program
12 only in accordance with a contract between the department and a
13 grant recipient. The contract must include provisions under which
14 the department is granted sufficient control to ensure the public
15 purpose of providing emergency response mapping services to
16 critical infrastructure facilities to which this subchapter
17 applies is accomplished and the state receives a return benefit.

18 Sec. 424.155. CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE EMERGENCY RESPONSE
19 MAP FUND. (a) The critical infrastructure emergency response map
20 fund is a dedicated account in the general revenue fund
21 administered by the department.

22 (b) The fund consists of:

23 (1) legislative appropriations of money to the
24 department for deposit to the credit of the fund for purposes of
25 this subchapter;

26 (2) any revenue that by law is dedicated for deposit to
27 the fund;

1 (3) interest or other earnings on money credited to or
2 allocable to the fund; and

3 (4) gifts, grants, including federal grants, or
4 donations received by the department for the fund.

5 (c) Money in the fund may be appropriated only to the
6 department to administer the grant program and award grants under
7 Section 424.154.

8 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
9 of this Act, the Department of Public Safety of the State of Texas
10 shall establish the grant program required under Section 424.154,
11 Government Code, as added by this Act.

12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
