H.B. No. 4346

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT
2 relating to the release of motor vehicle collision report
3 information.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 550.065, Transportation Code, is amended
6 by amending Subsections (b), (c), and (f) and adding Subsection
7 (e-1) to read as follows:

10 (1) the department; and

11 (2) an agency of the United States, this state, or a
12 local government of this state that has use for the information for
13 [collision prevention] purposes of collision prevention or a
14 criminal investigation conducted by a law enforcement agency.

15 (c) On written request and payment of any required fee, the
16 department or the governmental entity shall release the information
17 to:

18 (1) an entity described by Subsection (b);

19 (2) the law enforcement agency that employs the peace
20 officer who investigated the collision and sent the information to
21 the department, including a person acting on behalf [an agent] of
22 the law enforcement agency who is authorized by contract to obtain
23 the information;

24 (3) the court in which a case involving a person

1 involved in the collision is pending if the report is subpoenaed; or
2 (4) any person directly concerned in the collision or
3 having a proper interest therein, including:
4 (A) any person involved in the collision;
5 (B) the authorized representative of any person
6 involved in the collision;
7 (C) a driver involved in the collision;
8 (D) an employer, parent, or legal guardian of a
9 driver involved in the collision;
10 (E) the owner of a vehicle or property damaged in
11 the collision;
12 (F) a person who has established financial
13 responsibility for a vehicle involved in the collision in a manner
14 described by Section [601.051](#), including a policyholder of a motor
15 vehicle liability insurance policy covering the vehicle;
16 (G) an insurance company that issued an insurance
17 policy covering a vehicle involved in the collision;
18 (H) an insurance company that issued a policy
19 covering any person involved in the collision;
20 (I) a person under contract to provide claims or
21 underwriting information to a person described by Paragraph (F),
22 (G), or (H);
23 (J) a radio or television station that holds a
24 license issued by the Federal Communications Commission;
25 (K) a newspaper that is:
26 (i) a free newspaper of general circulation
27 or qualified under Section [2051.044](#), Government Code, to publish

1 legal notices;

2 (ii) published at least once a week; and

3 (iii) available and of interest to the

4 general public in connection with the dissemination of news;

5 (L) any person who may sue because of death

6 resulting from the collision; or

7 (M) an employee or authorized representative of a

8 vehicle storage facility, as defined by Section [2303.002](#),

9 Occupations Code, that stored a vehicle involved in the collision

10 [~~accident~~].

11 (e-1) In addition to the information required to be released

12 under Subsection (c), the governmental entity may release a vehicle

13 identification number and specific collision information relating

14 to that vehicle to a person described by Subsection (c)(2).

15 (f) The department or the governmental entity when

16 releasing information under Subsection (c-1), ~~(e)~~ (e), or (e-1):

17 (1) may not release personal information, as defined

18 by Section [730.003](#); and

19 (2) shall withhold or redact the following items:

20 (A) the first, middle, and last name of any

21 person listed in a collision report, including a vehicle driver,

22 occupant, owner, or lessee, a bicyclist, a pedestrian, or a

23 property owner;

24 (B) the number of any driver's license,

25 commercial driver's license, or personal identification

26 certificate issued to any person listed in a collision report;

27 (C) the date of birth, other than the year, of any

1 person listed in a collision report;

2 (D) the address, other than zip code, and

3 telephone number of any person listed in a collision report;

4 (E) the license plate number of any vehicle

5 listed in a collision report;

6 (F) the name of any insurance company listed as a

7 provider of financial responsibility for a vehicle listed in a

8 collision report;

9 (G) the number of any insurance policy issued by

10 an insurance company listed as a provider of financial

11 responsibility;

12 (H) the date the peace officer who investigated

13 the collision was notified of the collision;

14 (I) the date the investigating peace officer

15 arrived at the collision site;

16 (J) the badge number or identification number of

17 the investigating officer;

18 (K) the date on which any person who died as a

19 result of the collision died;

20 (L) the date of any commercial motor vehicle

21 report; and

22 (M) the place where any person injured or killed

23 in a collision was taken and the person or entity that provided the

24 transportation.

25 SECTION 2. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails

26 over another Act of the 89th Legislature, Regular Session, 2025,

27 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted

1 codes.

2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
