- 8 section, "education service center region" means a geographic

- 2 (d) Not later than January 1 of each odd-numbered year, the
- 3 commission shall prepare a report identifying areas of each
- 4 district's operations that do not effectively or efficiently use
- 5 the district's funds and that detract from instructional spending
- 6 and make recommendations to address its findings. The commission's
- 7 review may also include recommendations related to the district's
- 8 governance, management, operating structure, and compliance with
- 9 legislative requirements.
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
