2	(d) The commission shall prepare a report identifying areas
3	of each district's operations that do not effectively or
4	efficiently use the district's funds and that detract from
5	instructional spending and make recommendations to address its
6	findings. The commission's review may also include recommendations
7	related to the district's governance, management, operating
8	structure, and compliance with legislative requirements.
9	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
