## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to establishing policies regarding the timely issuance of
- 3 emergency notifications at public institutions of higher

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 61, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 61.070 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 61.070. COORDINATION OF EMERGENCY NOTIFICATIONS. The
- 9 board, in consultation with administrators, faculty, staff, and
- 10 students at institutions of higher education, shall adopt rules
- 11 regarding standardized procedures for timely issuing emergency
- 12 <u>notifications in accordance with the Jeanne Clery Campus Safety Act</u>
- 13 (20 U.S.C. Section 1092(f)), including emergency alerts through the
- 14 system required under Section 51.218.
- 15 SECTION 2. The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board
- 16 shall adopt the rules required by Section 61.070, Education Code,
- 17 as added by this Act, as soon as practicable after the effective
- 18 date of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
