- SECTION 2. Subchapter F, Chapter 143, Local Government 15
- 16 Code, is amended by adding Section 143.091 to read as follows:
- Sec. 143.091. ELIGIBILITY FOR CIVILIAN OVERSIGHT BOARD. A 17
- person is not eligible to serve on a civilian oversight board if the 18
- person has been: 19
- (1) convicted of or placed on deferred adjudication 20
- community supervision for a felony offense; or 21
- (2) convicted of a crime of moral turpitude. 22
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 2.4

- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
