## 1 document required to be delivered under Section 1202.003(b)(2) in 2 an electronic format and accompanied by an electronic signature, if 3 applicable.

4 SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2025, in accordance 5 with Section 402.044, Government Code, the attorney general shall advise the proper legal authorities in regard to the issuance of 6 bonds that by law require the attorney general's approval that 7 8 Section 1202.0035, Government Code, as added by this Act, requires electronic submission of public securities and advise those persons 9 10 of any other procedural changes to the submission and registration requirements of public securities under Chapter 1202, Government 11 12 Code, as amended by this Act, that the attorney general deems necessary to efficiently receive electronic submissions of public 13 14 securities after the effective date of this Act.

15 SECTION 3. Section 1202.0035, Government Code, as added by this Act, applies only to a public security, record of proceedings, 16 17 or credit agreement submitted to the attorney general under Section 1202.003, Government Code, on or after the effective date of this 18 19 Act. A public security, record of proceedings, or credit agreement submitted before the effective date of this Act is governed by the 20 21 law in effect on the date the security, record, or agreement was submitted, and the former law is continued in effect for that 22 23 purpose.
