- 5 SECTION 1. Sec. 1802.051, Occupations Code, is amended by
- 6 adding subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 7 LICENSE REQUIRED. (a) A person may not act as an auctioneer
- 8 or associate auctioneer in this state unless the person holds a
- 9 license issued by the department under this chapter.

- 12 (c) Except as provided by Subsection (d), an individual who
- 13 is licensed under this chapter may not act as an auctioneer or
- 14 associate auctioneer for an entity unless the entity:
- 15 (1) is an auction company owned or operated by an
- 16 individual who is licensed under this chapter; or
- 17 (2) is a real estate brokerage firm that is operated by
- 18 a broker licensed by the Texas Real Estate Commission.
- 19 (d) An individual who is licensed under this chapter may
- 20 conduct an auction to sell motor vehicles, as defined by Section
- 21 501.002 or 502.001, Transportation Code, for a person who holds:
- 22 (1) a dealer general distinguishing number or a
- 23 wholesale motor vehicle auction general distinguishing number
- 24 issued under Subchapter B, Chapter 503, Transportation Code; or

- 1 (2) a license issued under Subchapter C, Chapter 2302.
- 2 (e) Notwithstanding any other provision in this Chapter,
- 3 the Department may issue an auctioneer's license to corporations
- 4 pursuant to rules promulgated by the Commission.
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
