(a) 9 section applies only to a municipality with a population of more 10 than 100,000. 11 12 (b) In this section, "affordable housing project" means a housing development project that has received an allocation of low 13 14 income housing tax credits under Subchapter DD, Chapter 2306, Government Code. 15 (c) An application for a building permit for an affordable 16 housing project submitted to a municipality for review must be 17 granted or denied by the municipality in no more than 50 percent of 18 the time allotted by the municipality to grant or deny any 19 residential building permit application. 20 21 (d) If the municipality has adopted an accelerated residential building permit review process, an applicant for a 22

building permit for an affordable housing project shall be allowed

to submit the application for review under the accelerated process.
