(a) In this section, "miniature vehicle" has the meaning assigned by Section 8 9 502.001. (b) For the purposes of issuing a title under this chapter, 10 a miniature vehicle is considered to be a motor vehicle. 11 12 (c) This section applies only to a miniature vehicle that: 13 (1) was 25 years of age or older at the time of import 14 into the United States; or 15 (2) at the time of the issuance of the title, is 25 16 years of age or older and has previously been issued a valid title in the United States. 17 18 SECTION 2. Section 502.001, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Subdivision (21-a) to read as follows: 19 (21-a) "Miniature vehicle" means a miniature car, 20 21 truck, van, or bus manufactured in Japan that: 22 (A) is powered by an internal combustion engine 23 with a displacement of 1,200 cubic centimeters or less; 24 (B) has a width of 60 inches or less;

2	(D) has a height of 80 inches or less;
3	(E) has a top speed of at least 50 miles per hour;
4	(F) is designed to propel itself with four or
5	more tires in contact with the ground;
6	(G) is equipped with:
7	(i) a speedometer; and
8	(ii) all equipment required for miniature
9	vehicles under Section 547.106 or rules adopted by the Department
10	of Public Safety under Section 547.106; and
11	(H) has a manufacturer's permanent vehicle

13	SECTION 3. Subchapter A, Chapter 502, Transportation Code,
14	is amended by adding Section 502.006 to read as follows:

16	purposes of registering a vehicle under this chapter, a miniature
17	vehicle is considered to be a motor vehicle.
18	(b) This section applies only to a miniature vehicle that:

20	into the United States; or
21	(2) at the time of registration is 25 years of age or
22	older and has previously been issued a valid title in the United

24	SECTION 4. Subchapter I, Chapter 545, Transportation Code,

2	(b) A person may operate a miniature vehicle on a public

8	SECTION 5. Subchapter B, Chapter 547, Transportation Code,
9	is amended by adding Section 547.106 to read as follows:

11	In this section, "miniature vehicle" has the meaning assigned by
12	<u>Section 502.001.</u>
13	(b) A miniature vehicle must be equipped with the following
14	items in compliance with this chapter:
15	(1) headlamps;
16	(2) stoplamps;
17	(3) turn signal lamps;
18	(4) tail lamps;
19	(5) parking brake;
20	(6) rearview mirror; and
21	(7) windshield wipers.
22	(c) A provision of this chapter that requires equipment not
23	listed in Subsection (b) does not apply to a miniature vehicle
24	unless the department by rule specifically applies the provision to
25	miniature vehicles.
26	SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
