- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 42.0421, Human Resources Code, is
- 6 amended by amending Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 7 (f) The training required by this section must be
- 8 appropriately targeted and relevant to the age of the children who
- 9 will receive care from the individual receiving training and must
- 10 be provided by <u>a Texas independent school district</u>, the Texas
- 11 Education Agency, or a person who:
- 12 (1) is a training provider registered with the Texas
- 13 Early Childhood Professional Development System's Texas Trainer
- 14 Registry that is maintained by the Texas Head Start State
- 15 Collaboration Office;
- 16 (2) is an instructor at a public or private secondary
- 17 school, an institution of higher education, as defined by Section
- 18 61.003, Education Code, or a private college or university
- 19 accredited by a recognized accrediting agency who teaches early
- 20 childhood development or another relevant course, as determined by
- 21 rules adopted by the commissioner of education and the commissioner
- 22 of higher education;
- 23 (3) is an employee of a state agency with relevant
- 24 expertise;

- 1 (4) is a physician, psychologist, licensed
- 2 professional counselor, social worker, or registered nurse;
- 3 (5) holds a generally recognized credential or
- 4 possesses documented knowledge relevant to the training the person
- 5 will provide;
- 6 (6) is a registered family home care provider or
- 7 director of a day-care center or group day-care home in good
- 8 standing with the department, if applicable, and who:
- 9 (A) has demonstrated core knowledge in child
- 10 development and caregiving; and
- 11 (B) is only providing training at the home or
- 12 center in which the provider or director and the person receiving
- 13 training are employed; or
- 14 (7) has at least two years of experience working in
- 15 child development, a child development program, early childhood
- 16 education, a childhood education program, or a Head Start or Early
- 17 Head Start program and:
- 18 (A) has been awarded a Child Development
- 19 Associate (CDA) credential; or
- 20 (B) holds at least an associate's degree in child
- 21 development, early childhood education, or a related field.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
