A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to the authority of the Public Utility Commission of Texas 1-21 1-22 to retain assistance for regional proceedings affecting certain 1-23 electric utilities and consumers. 1-24

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 39, Utilities Code, is amended by adding Section 39.004 to read as follows: 1-25 1-26

Sec. 39.004. HIRING ASSISTANCE FOR REGIONAL PROCEEDINGS. The commission may retain any consultant, accountant, auditor, 1-27 1-28 (a) engineer, or attorney the commission considers necessary to 1-29 represent the commission in a proceeding before a regional 1-30 1-31 transmission organization, or before a court reviewing proceedings of a regional transmission organization, related to: (1) the relationship of an electric utility to a power 1-32

1 - 33region, regional transmission organization, or independent system 1-34 1-35 operator;

(2) the approval of an agreement among an electric utility and the electric utility's affiliates concerning the coordination of the operations of the electric utility and the 1-36 1-37 1-38 electric utility's affiliates; or 1-39

(3) other matters related to an electric utility that 1 - 40<u>may</u> affect the ultimate rates paid by retail customers in this 1-41 state. 1-42 1-43 (b) Assistance for which a consultant, accountant, auditor,
