## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the use of municipal hotel occupancy tax revenue and

3 certain tax revenue derived from a hotel and convention center

4 project by certain municipalities.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 351.101(q), Tax Code, is amended to read

7 as follows:

8 (q) In addition to the purposes provided by Subsections (a)

9 and (e), a municipality described by Section 351.152(75) or a

10 municipality with a population of more than 10,000 that has a city

11 hall located less than three miles from a space center operated by

12 an agency of the federal government and that is wholly located in a

13 county with a population of four million or more may use revenue

14 from the hotel occupancy tax for the construction, improvement,

15 enlarging, equipping, renovating, repairing, operation, and

16 maintenance of a coliseum or multiuse facility and related

17 infrastructure or a venue, as defined by Section 334.001(4), Local

18 Government Code, that is related to the promotion of tourism,

19 including a hotel, resort, or convention center facility located on

20 land owned by the municipality or a nonprofit corporation acting on

21 behalf of the municipality. This subsection does not authorize a

22 <u>municipality described by Section 351.152(75) to use revenue from</u>

23 the hotel occupancy tax for the construction, improvement,

24 enlarging, equipping, renovating, repairing, operation, or

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1 maintenance of a road, street, or water or sewer facility.

- 6 SECTION 3. Section 351.161(a), Tax Code, as added by
- 7 Chapter 1030 (S.B. 627), Acts of the 88th Legislature, Regular
- 8 Session, 2023, is amended to read as follows:
- 9 (a) This section applies only to a municipality described by
- 10 Section 351.152(5) or (75).
- 11 SECTION 4. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails
- 12 over another Act of the 89th Legislature, Regular Session, 2025,
- 13 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted
- 14 codes.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
