3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 419.029, Government Code, is amended to

5 read as follows:

6 Sec. 419.029. TRAINING CURRICULUM. (a) The commission may

7 establish minimum curriculum requirements for preparatory,

8 in-service, and advanced courses and programs for a school operated

by or for this state or a local government specifically for training

10 fire protection personnel or recruits.

11 (b) The minimum curriculum requirements established by the

12 commission under Subsection (a) must require training on conducting

13 <u>a fire safety inspection at a public or private school in accordance</u>

14 with Section 419.909.

15 SECTION 2. Section 419.909, Government Code, is amended by

16 adding Subsections (b-1), (b-2), and (b-3) to read as follows:

17 (b-1) A fire safety inspection of a public or private

18 school, including an open-enrollment charter school, required by a

19 state or local law, rule, regulation, or ordinance must include an

20 examination of each automated external defibrillator, as defined by

21 Section 779.001, Health and Safety Code, on the school campus to

22 determine whether the defibrillator is fully functional, which must

23 include verifying that that defibrillator's pads and battery have

24 not expired and that the defibrillator's status indicator light

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- 1 indicates that the device is ready for use. A representative of the
- 2 school campus shall present each automated external defibrillator
- 3 for inspection.
- 4 (b-2) A person who conducts a fire safety inspection
- 5 described by Subsection (b-1) must:
- 6 (1) provide a written report of the inspection and any
- 7 relevant paperwork pertaining to the findings of the inspection to:
- 8 (A) if the inspection is of a public school, the
- 9 principal of the school and the superintendent of the applicable
- 10 school district; or
- 11 (B) if the inspection is of a private school, the
- 12 director of the school; and
- 13 (2) at the time the person provides the report as
- 14 required by Subdivision (1), indicate on the report the method by
- 15 which, and the time and date on which, the person provided the
- 16 report to the appropriate person under that subdivision.
- 17 (b-3) The report required under Subsection (b-2) must be
- 18 filed:
- 19 (1) at the school campus to which the report relates;
- 20 and
- 21 (2) according to the year in which the inspection
- 22 <u>occurred.</u>
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
