IMMUNITY FROM LIABILITY AND SUIT. eligible entity granted a charter under this subchapter is immune 17 from liability and suit in matters related to the operation of an 18 adult education program under the charter to the same extent as a 19 school district, and its employees and volunteers are immune from 20

liability and suit to the same extent as school district employees
