16	Sec. 12.2525. IMMUNITY FROM LIABILITY AND SUIT. An
17	eligible entity granted a charter under this subchapter is immune
18	from liability and suit in matters related to the operation of an
19	adult education program under the charter to the same extent as a
20	school district, and its employees and volunteers are immune from
21	liability and suit to the same extent as school district employees
22	and volunteers. A member of the governing body of the entity is
23	immune from liability and suit to the same extent as a school
24	district trustee.

1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
