A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

H.B. No. 4687

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the applicability of certain immunity and liability
- 3 laws to certain charter school campuses or programs.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 12.057(c), Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (c) A campus or program granted a charter under Section
- 8 12.052, 12.0521(a)(1), or 12.053 is immune from liability to the
- 9 same extent as a school district, and its employees and volunteers
- 10 are immune from liability to the same extent as school district
- 11 employees and volunteers. A member of the governing body of the
- 12 campus or program is immune from liability and suit to the same
- 13 <u>extent as a school district trustee.</u>
- 14 SECTION 2. Subchapter G, Chapter 12, Education Code, is
- 15 amended by adding Section 12.2525 to read as follows:
- Sec. 12.2525. IMMUNITY FROM LIABILITY AND SUIT. In matters
- 17 related to the operation of an adult education program under a
- 18 charter granted under this subchapter, an eligible entity is immune
- 19 from liability and suit to the same extent as a school district, and
- 20 <u>its employees and volunteers are immune from liability and suit to</u>
- 21 the same extent as school district employees and volunteers. A
- 22 member of the governing body of the entity is immune from liability
- 23 and suit to the same extent as a school district trustee.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
