- 17 (1) designated and recognized by this state as a
- 18 Native American Indian Tribe exercising substantial governmental

- 1 (b) All gaming activities prohibited by the laws of this
- 2 state are prohibited on the reservation and lands of the Lipan
- 3 Apache Tribe of Texas. A person who violates this subsection is
- 4 liable for the same civil and criminal penalties provided by state
- 5 law for engaging in the prohibited gaming activities.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
