H.B. No. 4742

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

# 1 AN ACT

2 relating to the ability of a school district to request an appraisal  
3 of property by the appraisal district.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 25.18, Tax Code, is amended by adding  
6 subsection (d) to read as follows:

7       (d) If the appraisal district does not reappraise property  
8       in a tax year, a school district by resolution adopted by its  
9       governing body may require the appraisal office to reappraise all  
10      property within the school district pursuant to Section 23.01(a).  
11      On or before the deadline requested by the school district, which  
12      deadline may not be less than 30 days after the date the resolution  
13      is delivered to the appraisal office, the chief appraiser shall  
14      complete the reappraisal and deliver to the school district  
15      supplemental appraisal records as provided by Section 25.23. The  
16      school district must pay the appraisal district for the cost of  
17      making the reappraisal. The chief appraiser shall provide  
18      sufficient personnel to make the reappraisals required by this  
19      subsection on or before the deadline requested by the school  
20      district.

21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2026.
