USE OF MULTIPLE AWARD PURCHASING PROCEDURE. 23 (a) The comptroller or a state agency may use the multiple award purchasing procedure described by this subchapter to award a 24

- 23 (b) Each contractor must provide, or be capable of

- 3 or agency may conduct a secondary solicitation competition among
