- 6 SECTION 1. This Act may be cited as the Cindy Clemishire
- 7 Act.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 16.003(a), Civil Practice and Remedies
- 9 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 10 (a) Except as provided by Sections 16.010, 16.0031, [and]
- 11 16.0045, and 16.0046, a person must bring suit for trespass for
- 12 injury to the estate or to the property of another, conversion of
- 13 personal property, taking or detaining the personal property of
- 14 another, personal injury, forcible entry and detainer, and forcible
- 15 detainer not later than two years after the day the cause of action
- 16 accrues.
- SECTION 3. Section 16.0045(c), Civil Practice and Remedies
- 18 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 19 (c) In an action for injury resulting in death arising as a
- 20 result of conduct described by Subsection $[\frac{(a) \text{ or}}{(b)}]$ (b), the cause of
- 21 action accrues on the death of the injured person.
- 22 SECTION 4. Section 16.0045(a), Civil Practice and Remedies
- 23 Code, is redesignated as Section 16.0046, Civil Practice and
- 24 Remedies Code, and amended to read as follows:

- 1 Sec. 16.0046. NO LIMITATIONS PERIOD. [(a)] A person may
- 2 [must] bring a suit for personal injury at any time [not later than
- 3 30 years after the day the cause of action accrues] if the injury
- 4 arises as a result of conduct that violates:
- 5 (1) Section 22.011(a)(2), Penal Code (sexual assault
- 6 of a child);
- 7 (2) Section 22.021(a)(1)(B), Penal Code (aggravated
- 8 sexual assault of a child);
- 9 (3) Section 21.02, Penal Code (continuous sexual abuse
- 10 of young child or disabled individual);
- 11 (4) Section 20A.02(a)(7)(A), (B), (C), (D), or (H) or
- 12 Section 20A.02(a)(8), Penal Code, involving an activity described
- 13 by Section 20A.02(a)(7)(A), (B), (C), (D), or (H) or sexual conduct
- 14 with a child or disabled individual trafficked in the manner
- 15 described by Section 20A.02(a)(7), Penal Code (certain sexual
- 16 trafficking);
- 17 (5) Section 43.05(a)(2) or (3), Penal Code (compelling
- 18 prostitution by a child or disabled individual); or
- 19 (6) Section 21.11, Penal Code (indecency with a
- 20 child).
- 21 SECTION 5. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 22 a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of
- 23 this Act. A cause of action that accrued before the effective date
- 24 of this Act is governed by the law as it existed immediately before
- 25 the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect
- 26 for that purpose.
- 27 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
