- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 2161.001(2), Government Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (2) "Historically underutilized business" means an
- 9 entity with its principal place of business in this state that is:
- 10 (A) a corporation formed for the purpose of
- 11 making a profit in which 51 percent or more of all classes of the
- 12 shares of stock or other equitable securities are owned by one or
- 13 more economically disadvantaged persons who have a proportionate
- 14 interest and actively participate in the corporation's control,
- 15 operation, and management;
- 16 (B) a sole proprietorship created for the purpose
- 17 of making a profit that is completely owned, operated, and
- 18 controlled by an economically disadvantaged person;
- 19 (C) a partnership formed for the purpose of
- 20 making a profit in which 51 percent or more of the assets and
- 21 interest in the partnership are owned by one or more economically
- 22 disadvantaged persons who have a proportionate interest and
- 23 actively participate in the partnership's control, operation, and
- 24 management;

- 1 (D) a joint venture in which each entity in the
- 2 venture is a historically underutilized business, as determined
- 3 under another paragraph of this subdivision; [ex]
- 4 (E) a supplier contract between a historically
- 5 underutilized business as determined under another paragraph of
- 6 this subdivision and a prime contractor under which the
- 7 historically underutilized business is directly involved in the
- 8 manufacture or distribution of the goods or otherwise warehouses
- 9 and ships the goods; or
- 10 (F) a small business concern owned and controlled
- 11 by veterans that is certified as a veteran-owned small business by
- 12 the United States Small Business Administration.
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
