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A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-19 relating to duties of the vital statistics unit of the Department of 1-20 State Health Services in relation to certain suits affecting the 1-21 parent-child relationship, including in regard to the electronic 1-22 1-23 transmission of certain information.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 155.101, Family Code, is amended by 1-25 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (e) to read as 1-26 follows:

The vital statistics unit shall, on the [written] 1-27 (b) 1-28 request of the Department of Family and Protective Services, the 1-29 court, an attorney, or a party:

1-30 (1)identify the court that last had continuing, 1-31 exclusive jurisdiction of the child in a suit and give the docket number of the suit; or 1-32

1-33 (2) state that the child has not been the subject of a 1-34 suit.

(e) Using existing resources, the vital statistics unit shall establish an electronic process through which the Department 1-35 1-36 of Family and Protective Services may request information under this section. 1-37 1-38

1-39 SECTION 2. Section 160.422, Family Code, is amended by 1-40 adding Subsection (a-1) and amending Subsection (b) to read as 1-41 follows:

(a-1) Using existing resources, the vital statistics unit shall establish an electronic process through which the Department 1-42 1-43 1 - 44of Family and Protective Services may request information under 1-45 this section.

(b) The certificate of the results of a search must include 1-46 1-47 a digitized or written signature [be signed] on behalf of the unit 1-48 and state that:
