1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to duties of the vital statistics unit of the Department of
1-20 State Health Services in relation to certain suits affecting the
1-21 parent-child relationship, including in regard to the electronic
1-22 transmission of certain information.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 155.101, Family Code, is amended by
1-25 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (e) to read as
1-26 follows:

1-27 (b) The vital statistics unit shall, on the ~~written~~
1-28 request of the Department of Family and Protective Services, the
1-29 court, an attorney, or a party:

1-30 (1) identify the court that last had continuing,
1-31 exclusive jurisdiction of the child in a suit and give the docket
1-32 number of the suit; or

1-33 (2) state that the child has not been the subject of a
1-34 suit.

1-35 (e) Using existing resources, the vital statistics unit
1-36 shall establish an electronic process through which the Department
1-37 of Family and Protective Services may request information under
1-38 this section.

1-39 SECTION 2. Section 160.422, Family Code, is amended by
1-40 adding Subsection (a-1) and amending Subsection (b) to read as
1-41 follows:

1-42 (a-1) Using existing resources, the vital statistics unit
1-43 shall establish an electronic process through which the Department
1-44 of Family and Protective Services may request information under
1-45 this section.

1-46 (b) The certificate of the results of a search must include
1-47 a digitized or written signature ~~be signed~~ on behalf of the unit
1-48 and state that:

1-49 (1) a search has been made of the registry; and

1-50 (2) a registration containing the information
1-51 required to identify the registrant:

1-52 (A) has been found and is attached to the
1-53 certificate; or

1-54 (B) has not been found.

1-55 SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date
1-56 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
1-57 Services Commission shall adopt rules necessary to implement the
1-58 changes in law made by this Act.

1-59 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
1-60 a request received by the vital statistics unit of the Department of
1-61 State Health Services on or after January 1, 2026. A request

2-1 received before January 1, 2026, is governed by the law in effect
2-2 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the former
2-3 law is continued in effect for that purpose.

2-4 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
