1-21 relating to civil liability of property owners relating to
1-22 motorcycle instruction and training courses.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Chapter 662, Transportation Code, is amended by
1-25 adding Section 662.014 to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 662.014. LIMITATION ON LIABILITY FOR PROPERTY OWNERS.

1-27 (a) An owner of property on which instruction on motorcycle
1-28 operation and safety by an instructor or an instructor training
1-29 course takes place is not liable for any act or omission that occurs
1-30 during the instruction or course.

1-31 (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to a cause of action
1-32 arising from an act or omission constituting gross negligence,
1-33 recklessness, or intentional misconduct.

1-34 SECTION 2. Section 662.014, Transportation Code, as added
1-35 by this Act, applies only to a cause of action that accrues on or
1-36 after the effective date of this Act.

1-37 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
