(a) The board shall designate the second 9 full week of October as Free College Application Week. During the 10 designated week, the board shall permit individuals in this state 11 12 to apply to any institution of higher education for undergraduate admission without paying an application fee. 13 14 (b) The board may adopt rules as necessary to implement

16 SECTION 2. Section 61.0731, Education Code, as added by 17 this Act, applies beginning with the 2025-2026 academic year.

18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
