5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 552, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 552.164 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 552.164. EXCEPTION: CONFIDENTIALITY OF INFORMATION
8	REGARDING FRAUD DETECTION AND DETERRENCE MEASURES. Information in
9	the custody of a governmental body that relates to fraud detection
10	and deterrence measures is confidential and excepted from the
11	requirements of Section 552.021. For purposes of this section,
12	fraud detection information includes risk assessments, reports,
13	data, protocols, technology specifications, manuals, instructions,
14	investigative materials, crossmatches, mental impressions, and
15	communications that may reveal the methods or means by which a
16	governmental body prevents, investigates, or evaluates fraud.
17	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
