A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the composition of the advisory committee for metal 3 recycling entities. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 1956.017(b), Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 The advisory committee consists of 17 [15] members 7 (b) appointed by the director as follows: 8 (1) one representative of the department; 9 (2) two representatives of local law enforcement 10 11 agencies located in different municipalities, each with a 12 population of 500,000 or more; (3) two representatives of local law enforcement 13 14 agencies located in different municipalities, each with a population of 200,000 or more but less than 500,000; 15 (4) one representative of a local law enforcement 16 agency located in a municipality with a population of less than 17 200,000; 18 (5) five representatives of metal recycling entities, 19 20 at least one of whom must have substantial business experience with 21 transactions involving the purchase or acquisition of catalytic 22 converters; (6) two members who represent industries that are 23 24 impacted by theft of regulated material;

No. 4954 1 (7) one sheriff of a county with a population of 500,000 or more; [and] 2 3 (8) one sheriff of a county with a population of less 4 than 500,000; (9) one sheriff who has experience investigating the 5 6 theft of tubular steel used in the process of drilling and 7 completing oil and gas wells; and (10) one member who represents the oil and gas 8 9 industry. SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date 10 of this Act, the public safety director of the Department of Public 11 Safety of the State of Texas shall appoint two additional members to 12 the advisory committee as required by Section 1956.017, Occupations 13 14 Code, as amended by this Act. 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
