- 5 SECTION 1. Section 209.005(o), Property Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (o) A party that [If the property owners' association]
- 8 prevails in an action under Subsection (n)[, the association] is
- 9 entitled to a judgment for court costs and attorney's fees incurred
- 10 by the party [association] in connection with the action.
- 11 SECTION 2. Chapter 209, Property Code, is amended by adding
- 12 Section 209.018 to read as follows:
- Sec. 209.018. WITHHOLDING OF ASSESSMENTS BY PROPERTY OWNER.
- 14 (a) Notwithstanding a provision in a dedicatory instrument or
- 15 other law, if a property owner brings an action against a property
- 16 owners' association, the property owner may withhold assessment
- 17 payments while the action is pending.
- 18 (b) If a property owners' association prevails in an action
- 19 brought by a property owner, the property owner shall pay all
- 20 assessments withheld under Subsection (a) and resume assessment
- 21 payments.
- (c) A property owners' association may not file a suit to
- 23 collect assessments withheld under Subsection (a) against an owner
- 24 who prevails in an action against the property owners' association.

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- 1 SECTION 3. Section 209.005, Property Code, as amended by
- 2 this Act, and Section 209.018, Property Code, as added by this Act,
- 3 apply only to an action filed on or after the effective date of this
- 4 Act. An action filed before the effective date of this Act is
- 5 governed by the law in effect on the date the action was filed, and
- 6 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
